#### **RECITAL FEE - Due March 15th**

The Recital Fee of \$135.00 per student and is due March 15th. This fee covers all performance costs associated with the production: stage, sound, and lighting technicians, auditorium rental, security, janitorial, etc.

#### REHEARSALS

CLASS ATTENDANCE IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT. The choreography for the Production will be rehearsed in class. Therefore, students are expected to attend ALL prescribed classes. Our classes and lessons taught are vital toward the outcome of the production. We will be working hard in class with choreography, and <u>absences will inhibit the progress of the group.</u>

Because of this, absences during this season (after February 1, 2018) are disrespectful to fellow students and faculty. Therefore, more than 3 absences without a medical excuse (ie. Illness, injury, etc.) or <u>pre-approval</u> by the Directors (example: approval for mandatory school events or unavoidable work functions) after February 1, 2018 could result in dismissal from the Production and no refund will be granted.

- <u>In Studio Dress Rehearsal</u> will be during the student's class time the **week of May 21st.** More details will be handed out regarding this rehearsal closer to the performance. This is a mandatory rehearsal and all students must be in costume, full hair and makeup, along with the appropriate tights and shoes as if they were to perform that day on stage.
- <u>Stage Rehearsal</u> week is the week of June 4th. The Regular class schedule will NOT take place at the usual time at the studio\*\*, as the students will have their class on stage at the designated time (see below). Each class will be given a specific arrival time for rehearsal.

This week's classes will all take place on stage during prescribed stage time below. Regular class times will not be held at the studio this week . \*\* (Monday students will have class at the studio on June 4th in addition to their stage time.)



# **AT A GLANCE**

After working hard all year, the Year-End Production is a special stage experience that builds confidence, poise, and personality. One of the highlights of our concert is the **beautiful keepsake program book** that showcases our students. Each family is encouraged to support their dancer and the school by buying or selling an ad that can include a picture, words of wisdom, best wishes, or congratulations. Ask your family, friends, grandparents, aunts, uncles and local businesses to sponsor a picture page for your dancer! Students can be pictured together with a fellow dancer and the families can share the expense. Students can also purchase more than one ad. **Everyone should be a part! The dancers keep these into adulthood as sentimental yearbooks!** 

The book will be professionally prepared for our 2017/2018 school year. It will list all dances and every performer in each dance, as well as information about our school, Company, Team and Crew, award information, and more. It also contains a summary of highlights from the past year at the studio, lots of photos, and a page for the autographs of your favorite dancers.



Within the program book, advertising pages are offered for sale (priced by size). This is where local businesses and parents who own their own business can hit their target markets; or parents, relatives, and friends, can wish the dancers well.

# **PICTURE OPTIONS – RECITAL BOOK PICTURES**

If you wish to only purchase a picture for the recital book, you may forego selling ads.

- You may purchase multiple pictures in the recital book.
- A Picture Spot in the the front of the book is \$50 and if you purchase a \$150 Full Page Ad (an 8X10 picture page) you will receive a Picture Spot for **free**.
- Students may take pictures together.
- Students who purchase either a Picture Spot or \$150 worth of Ads will be included in the Class Picture.

Katharine Bentz will be taking pictures at her studio on **April 8th and April 15th.** She will be offering picture packages for purchase if you desire. (*Photographer Fees are separate from Picture Spot and Ad fees*)

# IS THERE A DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ADS AND PICTURES?

Yes. Ads are located in the second half of the recital book and may include text and photos, such as congratulatory notes to students, and business advertisements, and business cards. Ads 1/4 page size and larger may include pictures of students. Picture Spots photographed by Katharine Bentz are located primarily in the front half of the recital book. Picture Spots do not include text.

### **TO WHOM CAN I SELL ADS?**

You may sell ads to anyone and everyone that will purchase one from you. The easiest ads to get are from Mom, Dad, Grandmaw, Grandpaw, Nanny, and their businesses (sometimes businesses can get a tax write off for advertising!).

#### WHAT SHOULD I WRITE IN MY ADS?

You may write anything you wish to the student participating in the recital. Examples of ads will be available online on the student page of the website under "Dance Concert Book Example". Click 'Current Students' on the top of the page and scroll down. Password: cobastudent18

All ads at least 1/4 page size and larger can have any combination of words and or pictures. Your pictures, your words, you choose. All ads must be produced "camera ready". **We recommend emailing ads that contain photos.** We can accept most file types, however we prefer .PDF, .JPG, .PSD, .EPS format, or Mac formats.

#### CAN I REQUEST GRAPHICS OR ARTWORK IN MY AD?

Ads must be submitted camera ready. However, you can have the ad built for you **professionally for a \$40 fee.** The graphic designer and COBA will choose all graphics and artwork in the recital book according to the theme. However, graphics on business cards, professionally set and published ads, and ads emailed with a graphic already included are fine.

# CAN I RECEIVE A FREE PICTURE IN THE RECITAL BOOK?

Yes! In order to receive a FREE picture in the book, you will have to sell \$150 worth of ads. The more ads you sell, the more Picture Spots you can receive (up to 4) **Free**. The easiest way to receive a free picture in the recital book is to ask family to purchase ads. Keep in mind, if you sell \$1500, \$750, or \$500 worth of ads or more, your child will also receive all of the recognition listed above as well as **priority seating**!

## DO I HAVE TO SELL ADS OR A BUY A PICTURE?

Participation in the Ad Program is optional. Purchasing a picture in the recital book is also optional. If opting not to sell ads, you may purchase a picture in the recital book. However, you are not required to purchase a picture in the book. Please keep in mind - Students not purchasing a picture in the recital book or selling the specified dollar amount of ads to acquire a free picture in the recital book, <u>will not be included in class group pictures</u>. Also, should you decide not to purchase a picture in the recital book, you must notify COBA before April 1st. Otherwise COBA will assume that you want to purchase a picture in the recital program book and charge your account according to the Draft Schedule.

#### **COMPANY MEMBERS**

<u>COMPANY MEMBERS</u> - All Company, Team, and Dance Crew members are required to sell a minimum of **\$300 worth of ads** in order to have their headshot photo featured under Company/Team/Crew members in the program book, as well as a free picture spot in the front of the book.

# WHEN IS THE AD CONTEST DEADLINE?

All ads are due NO LATER than May 1st. The Cover Girls (and Boys) will be announced on May 5th!

### **HOW DO I SUBMIT ADS?**

Step 1: EMAIL ALL ADS to coba.ads@gmail.com. Ads emailed to any other address are not guaranteed to be in the recital book.

Step 2: In addition to the first step, please turn in a **TYPED hard copy of ads** along with collected money to the studio in sealed envelope with your child's name and class printed clearly on the front. Include the completed 'TOTALS' page at the end of this packet.

Step 3: Combine all checks and cash collected for sold ads. TURN IN EITHER 1 CHECK MADE TO The Conservatory of Ballet Aviv OR A SEALED ENVELOPE WITH CASH FOR THE TOTAL OF ADS SOLD TO COBA. (Checks collected from a business may be made to The Conservatory of Ballet Aviv.) \*\* With the large student base, both steps are crucial to ensure ad accuracy and correct placement in the recital book. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

# HOW DO I GET A RECITAL BOOK TO SEE MY ADS?

Every family participating in the recital will have one recital book ordered for them if they pre-order on March 15th for \$15. If you wish to order more, please send us an email. Recital books will be distributed the day of the recital.
